NB TV Licence. If you are living in private accommodation and have a television, then you will need to buy a television licence. The annual cost is £139.50. This can be paid in instalments. Payment can be made by direct debit, on line(www.tvlicencing.co.uk), by cheque or in cash at any local pay point. TV licencing in the UK is strictly enforced and anyone found without a licence could be fined a maximum of £1000.00.
