## Medical Information

There are 4 trained first-aid officers in the school

- Esther (Pembroke House)
- Joanna (Abon)
- Andrea (Abon)
- Sarah (Social Programme officer)

If you have any concerns, please speak to them.

- If you are really not well and you need to see a **Doctor** please go to Reception. We will make an appointment for you to see the School Doctor who has a surgery near the school. This service is a free.

The surgery hours are:

Monday to Friday 09.00 – 10.30 - Open surgery – no appointment needed.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 16.00 – 18.00. By appointment.

If the Doctor prescribes any **medicine** you will need to pay for that. You should take the prescription to the chemist – you will pay £7.10 per item.

- In an **emergency** or if you need emergency treatment at the weekend, you should go to the Accident and Emergency Department at the BRI Hospital (Bristol Royal Infirmary). This is situated in the centre of Bristol near the Bus Station.
- If you have a small problem but would like some advice, we suggest that you go to Boots, the pharmacy in Clifton Down Shopping Centre. Speak to the pharmacist. He/she will advise you and let you know which medicines to take. If the pharmacist thinks the problem is serious, he/she will advise you to go to the Doctor or to the hospital.
