

## MOBILE PHONES



We think it is a good idea if every student has a mobile phone. It is a good way for you to stay in touch with your friends in Bristol and if you have a mobile, we can always contact you in an emergency. Local calls are much cheaper if you use an English SIM card.

A SIM card will cost around £5.00

You might be able to buy a SIM card here and just put it in your own phone. (Sadly this won't work with Japanese, Taiwanese or Korean mobiles)

If you have to buy a new phone, you can buy one for under £20.00. (Including the SIM)

There are a few mobile phone shops on Whiteladies Road:

To top up your mobile phone you can buy vouchers from most newsagents and supermarkets, like **Sainsbury's**, and **Tesco** on Whiteladies Road.

There are different phone networks that you can join- **Vodafone, Orange, O2 and 3** are the most popular ones.

If you need advice on which networks are cheapest for phoning your own country, just ask the staff in the phone shop and they should tell you what the best deal is for you.
