What is your level of English?

Students coming to the UK with a General Student Visa must be at least at level B1 (intermediate), ready to start a course at B2 level (upper-intermediate).

To prove your level, you must send us a copy of a certificate from one of the recognised tests on the SELT list (secure English language tests) and you will need to show the original certificate when you apply to the Embassy for your visa.

Approved examinations include:

- IELTS - at least level 4 in all 4 papers
- BULATS – at least 40 in reading and listening and CEFR B1 in speaking and writing
- TOEFL – at least 4 in reading, 9 in listening, 16 in speaking and 13 in writing
- TOEIC – at least 275 in reading and listening and 120 in speaking and writing
